



# DOODLES ELITE — HEALTH GUARANTEE

## *Limited 1-Year Guarantee*

### **Prior to Pick-Up or Delivery**

It is the sole discretion of the breeder to determine when a puppy is ready to transition to its new home. Puppies are typically ready between **7–8 weeks of age**, depending on their weight, development, and ability to wean from the mother. Under no circumstances will a puppy leave before it is ready.

A **\$35 per day boarding fee** applies to puppies kept at **9 weeks of age** or older.

The puppy is guaranteed to be in **good health at the time of sale**.

All puppies will be **up to date on vaccinations and deworming** at the time of pick-up or delivery. It is essential that the buyer continues all recommended vaccinations and deworming. Puppies should not be exposed to unvaccinated dogs until the full vaccination series is completed, typically around **16–20 weeks of age**.

Each puppy will have been examined by a **licensed veterinarian** and deemed healthy prior to release.

### **Upon Pick-Up or Delivery**

The buyer must have the puppy examined by a **licensed veterinarian**, at the buyer's expense, within **7 days** of receiving the puppy. Failure to complete this examination within 7 days renders this guarantee **void**.

If, within this 7-day period, a licensed veterinarian determines the puppy to be unhealthy or unfit for sale, the veterinarian must provide a **written statement** declaring the puppy “unhealthy for purchase.”

This written diagnosis must be submitted to the breeder and will be reviewed by the breeder's licensed veterinarian. If the puppy is confirmed to be in poor health due to a condition clearly attributable to the breeder, the puppy may be returned for a **refund of the purchase price only**. *Deposit, Veterinary fees, shipping costs, and related expenses are not refundable.*

The breeder cannot assume responsibility for the puppy after **7 days** from the pick-up/delivery date. The buyer is responsible for providing proper care, safety, and protection for the puppy.

## **Exceptions to This Guarantee**

This guarantee does **NOT** cover:

- Health issues resulting from **neglect, injury, or improper care** by the buyer
- Minor or common conditions, including but not limited to:
  - Colds
  - Allergies
  - Internal or external parasites
  - Underbites
  - Umbilical hernias
  - Grade 1 luxating patellas
- Any medical expenses incurred after the sale
- Training difficulties or behavioral issues
- Size predictions — while parent weights are provided, adult size cannot be guaranteed
- Fertility or show quality — puppies are sold as **top-quality pets only**
- Hypoglycemia occurring after the puppy is in the buyer's possession

If the puppy is **bred within the first year**, this guarantee becomes **null and void**.

## **Congenital Defects**

This guarantee **DOES** cover:

A **one-year guarantee** against congenital defects that adversely affect the puppy's health. This is valid if the family has been seen by a vet of their choosing within 7 days of pickup/delivery date.

If the guarantee is valid, and a veterinarian diagnoses a congenital or hereditary defect within 1 year of the pickup/delivery date, the veterinarian must provide a **written statement** confirming the condition.

In the event of death, a **necropsy** performed by a licensed veterinarian is required for refund consideration.

The buyer must notify the breeder of the veterinarian's **name, address, and phone number** within **two business days** of diagnosis. Failure to do so results in forfeiture of all rights under this guarantee.

Once confirmed by the breeder's veterinarian, the puppy may be returned for a **refund of the purchase price only - minus deposit**.

*Deposit, Vet fees, shipping costs, and related expenses are not refundable.*

## **Shipping Policy**

If the buyer arranges airline transport, the breeder cannot be held responsible for events outside their control once the puppy is in the airline's care.

If the buyer chooses, the breeder may arrange delivery through an independent, non-affiliated **Puppy Nanny** service at the buyer's expense. Once the puppy is transferred to the Puppy Nanny on the agreed pick-up/delivery date, the breeder is no longer responsible for the puppy's health or well-being.

All shipped puppies may be exposed to other animals during transport. The breeder is not liable for any health issues arising from shipping.

If a refund is approved for any reason outlined in this guarantee, **only the purchase price - minus the deposit** will be refunded. The breeder is not responsible for reimbursing veterinary bills, medications, shipping fees, or any additional expenses.
